Objective:

1. To provide the opportunity for both non-farm youth and youth from farms with other breeds to work with American Lineback Cattle.
2. To develop character, knowledge and sense of responsibility in participating youth.
3. To increase participation in the American Lineback junior programs.

Responsibilities of Owner and Lessee:

1. The recorded owner must be a member in good standing of the ALCR.
2. The lessee must be a member in good standing of the ALCR
3. The owner and lessee should be clear on the responsibilities regarding the leased animal.
4. The lessee shall file the completed lease agreement, registration paper and filing fee.
5. The owner will hold lessee harmless from any financial obligation for loss from injury or death of leased animal.
6. The lessee will hold the recorded owner harmless from any injury liability resulting from working with this leased animal.
7. The owner may terminate this lease early for due cause and must notify the President of the ALCR.
8. The owner will retain eligibility for open shows and will be listed as the breeder of any calf resulting from the breeding during the term lease.
9. The lessee will not be entitled to any production, genetic merit, or breeder awards with a leased animal.

Terms:

1. The program year will coincide with the calendar year.
2. The lessee must follow the Junior Show Rules.
3. To lease a cow, the animal must be leased by the junior as of January 1 of the current year.
4. To lease a calf or heifer, the junior must be leased 60 days prior to a Junior Lineback Show.
5. The lease may be renewed on an annual basis by filing a new lease agreement.
6. The lease will automatically terminate at the end of the program year unless a new lease is filed.
7. Entries must be shown by the lessee, in any accredited junior show, unless prior approval is granted in accordance with the junior show rules. A written statement must be hand delivered to the show chairperson by 5:00PM two days prior to the show for approval. The following needs to be included in the statement: Name and age of lessee, class of animal, name and age of alternate leadsperson, appropriate reason for substitution. If approved, the alternate must be the same age or younger as the lessee. Alternate must also be a member in good standing of the ALCR.
8. The lessee is limited to five (5) animals per year.

Fees: \$10 per year or \$30 for the lifetime of the animal



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Deadline: Post marked date 60 Days prior to the given junior show (no postage meters)
